Bursary Definitions

Rally Turnout

Pony

- Groomed, very well. No mud or stains.
- Hooves picked out and clean. It is not necessary to oil them.
- Mane and tail brushed and neatened.

Tack

- Cleaned, very well.
- All stitching in good repair!
- All metal work, including the bit are to be clean and shining.
- Well-fitting and appropriate for the task.

Rider

- Clean and tidy - wearing the appropriate clothing.
 - Approved riding hat or crash helmet.
 - Approved back protector.
 - Jodhpurs: Pale colour; White or Cream.
 - BHPC jumper or a plain navy jumper.
 - White or blue shirt/collared t-shirt with Pony Club tie.
 - Plain blue, navy or black silk or hat cover.
 - Hairnets for long hair are compulsory.
 - Black or brown Jodhpur boots with matching black or brown chaps or long rubber or leather riding boots.

Note: To ensure a rider's safety all jewellery must be removed before a rally commences, i.e. rings, earrings, necklaces, etc.

Definitions:

1. 'Sportsmanship' - this can be defined by the member's tendency and display of comradeship, fairness, equality and respect.
2. 'Irish Pony Club (IPC) Ethos' - the member who shows a good disposition, good conduct, kindness and is helpful.
3. 'Horsemanship' - attitude, care and handling of their pony, rider ability - relative to their age and standard, efforts made to improve their horsemanship.
4. Dedication and Commitment - this is shown through the member's efforts to adhere to the Irish Pony Club ideals, attend rallies wherever possible and strive to abide by IPC standards.
